



PROTECTION FRAMEWORK

EN ISO 20345: 2011 – Safety footwear used for general purposes. It includes, for example, mechanical risks, slip resistance, thermal risks, ergonomic behaviour.

For professional use:

Fishing - agriculture - food industry – cleaning, or other activities requiring this kind of protection.

PERFORMANCE

EN ISO 20345 (S4+CI+SRC)

S4 = Basic safety requirements + antistatic footwear + energy absorption in the heel region of at least 20 J + toe cap

CI = Cold insulation

SRC = Slip resistance on ceramic tile wetted with dilute soap solution + slip resistance on steel floor with glycerol

PRINCIPAL MATERIALS

Polyurethane

- Easy to clean and disinfect due to their extra smooth design

- Lighter and metal free

INSTRUCTIONS

- **CARE**
 - Clean the boots after every use with water and soap, using a soft brush.
 - Rinse away the remains of the detergent with water.
 - Allow to dry well at room temperature and in the shade.
- **STORAGE**
 - Store the boots in a well-ventilated and dry place.

i For maximum protection, check the condition of your boots thoroughly before each use.
